In December I booked a flight to Singapore from Phnom Penh. The employment pass (work permit) from Singapore immigration came through, with one added problem They would like me to register as an RN in Singapore. Unfortunately I've let my Canadian registration go since leaving Manorom Christian Hospital, Thailand in 2004. It seems this move to Singapore will require prayer at several stages along the way. Please pray that I can re-register in Canada, or that somehow I can register in Singapore. I'm excited about the move and change of fields. I've learned about Thai culture, then Malay culture (south Thailand), then learned about Khmer culture. Now I'll be learning about Chinese culture. There won't be a need for language learning in Singapore, they speak English there. This move to Singapore means I leave behind my friends, both Khmer and missionary here in Cambodia.
