In January we handed out the Operation Christmas child shoeboxes. Cofradia received 150 boxes. Each Sunday School child was encouraged to invite 2 friends. Children from 4 different villages were being included. How do we end up with exactly 150 kids, all of the right gender and age? The only solution was prayer. We contacted a host of kids from Canada, nieces, nephews, Sunday school children, and Jonathan's classmates from Linden Christian School. We had just over 130 kids most of whom do not come to church regularly. They sat still, participated, and listened. They were sooo excited! A big thank you to those of you who participated and especially to those who prayed.

Mari is one of several moms that brought their children to the party. She had been playing volleyball with us, and she heard the clear presentation of the gospel. The next day she showed up at church for the very first time, and a week later she came forward at an altar call and received Jesus Christ as her personal Saviour.

For various reasons, a number of couples in the church have never gotten married. Upon their request, we decided to host a wedding on Feb. 14th. To our surprise 13 couples signed up! We rented 400 chairs and decided to kill the cow, literally. (1,000 lbs) No one fainted or tripped and there was lots of food. God is faithful. While all of the couples are connected to the church, one of the groomsmen, Javier, accepted the Lord a couple of weeks prior to the wedding. To God be the Glory!
